YOUTH/ADULT SCHOLARSHIP TOURNAMENT RULES

1. The certified divisions of this tournament are certified by USBC. Certified entrants must hold a valid 2024-25 GR USBC membership or pay local dues of \$9.00. Non-members may purchase an associate membership. Youth bowlers must be a certified member of a GR USBC youth or adult/youth league for the current season. Adults in the non-certified adult division don't need to hold USBC membership but must pay a \$5.00 participation fee.
2. Youth bowlers will use 12 game average as of December 31, 2024, and verified by a league standing sheet. Adult bowlers will use the highest GRUSBC winter book average from the 2023-24 season, if none use 2023-24 summer average based on 21 games if no book average. Bowlers from other local associations will use the highest bowl.com average of 21 games. If adult bowlers do not have either average, they will use their highest current average based on 21 games verified by a league standing sheet at the time of bowling. If there is no proof of average at time of bowling the adult will use a 230 average. Uncertified adults will use an average for handicapping purposes of male 160 and female of 130. For Adults in the uncertified division who have a previous GR USBC verifiable average an adjustment may be made to entering average. Previous average minus assigned average divided by 2 will be added to the allowance to determine average. Handicap will be 90% of 230 for all bowlers.
3. Final entries close on January 31, 2025, at 6:45 P.M. Please remember the times that you requested as they will be the times you will bowl. Entries are scheduled on a first come serve basis. The Adult bowler is followed by youth bowler.
4. USBC rules will be followed for this tournament. Any protest must be filed in writing within 72 hours of the end of the last shift of the tournament. Protests will be decided by the tournament Director with the assistance of the tournament committee.
5. Scholarships will be awarded with a ratio of at least 1 for each 10 entries per division. Bowlers may place only once with the same partner.
6. There will be four divisions based on the youth bowler's average. There will be one division for all youth bowlers in the non-certified adult division. The average divisions are: 201 and up, 151 to 200, 101 to 150 and 100 and under, and Bumper. Bumper Division will bowl two games only with adults on adjacent pair of lanes.
7. Once submitted and accepted by the tournament director, entry fees are non-refundable. Returned check fee is \$25.00 plus any bank fee. Make checks payable to GR USBC.
8. Substitutes will be permitted and should report to the tournament office at least 1/2 hour before shift time. Late bowlers will be permitted to bowl starting with the current frame of the game and will receive 0 (zero) for frames missed.
9. Proper attire must be worn during the tournament.
10. Rule 319a, item 2 (10 pin rule) and rule 319d and 319e are waived. Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own averages, whether submitted by the bowler, team captain or others. If the submitted average is lower than required and results in more handicap the bowlers score is disqualified. If the submitted average is higher, then the awards will be based on the submitted average. Average corrections must be made by the end of the first game of the series.
